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Principal's Report – School Parents and Friends Meeting 21st July 2020

1. COVID-19:

We are now currently in Phase 4 of the Roadmap to Recovery as outlined by the state government. The major change is that parents/caregivers are now able to enter classrooms however, the 2 sqm rule applies so parents need to be aware of numbers of adults in classrooms. Parent help is now allowed in classrooms along with parent help in the canteen. We will slowly reintroduce general assemblies into the school however, we will need to delay the presence of parents until phase 5 is introduced due to social distancing.

2. Assemblies/School Masses

As mentioned in the previous point, school general assemblies will be reintroduced. The school will also reintroduce school Masses this term.

3. Emmaus Catholic Primary School

Towards the end of last term there was an announcement from the Executive Director of Catholic Education stating that the Catholic Education Commission of WA had approved the purchase of the Riverlands Montessori School in Dayton. An interim Principal from CEWA has been put in place until the end of the year and a substantive Principal has been appointed to work in the school from 2021.

4. School Improvement Process:

Since my arrival at Good Shepherd, I have observed what has taken place, visited classrooms and interviewed all the staff. COVID has meant that this process was a little more drawn out than first expected. On the last week of Term Two, I presented my observations to the staff along with, what I believe to be, a possible focus over the next 3 years. The areas of growth that were identified are as follows:

- Review/redevelop the school's strategic plan to ensure that it reflects the future direction of the school. No one interviewed mentioned the school's strategic plan so its relevance could be questioned.
- Revisiting the school's behaviour management plan with all staff involved in the review. All staff can then be held accountable to ensure that consistency is maintained. This plan could also make clear the 'non-negotiable' aspects that the students need to adhere to.
- The development or review of a school 'Vision for Learning'. If this exists, it wasn't made mention of and if it doesn't then it will be a good opportunity to develop one.
- It could be time for the school's Vision Statement along with its values to be revisited/reviewed. As mentioned earlier, no staff member referred to either of these two aspects in any way or form and this may indicate that it is no longer relevant.

The school will work with an outside consultant to assist with the development of these points.
