

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## Principal's Report – P&F Meeting June 2018

1. **NAPLAN Online**  
Naplan Online was completed by Year 3 and 5's for the first time. Feedback from the teachers was generally positive in the manner the children handled the Online tests.
2. **Sacramental Program**  
First Holy Communion was celebrated over the 26<sup>th</sup> / 27<sup>th</sup> May weekend. From all reports the Mass and Ceremony went beautifully.
3. **Staff PD – 1<sup>st</sup> June**  
Staff travelled to Mary's Mount Gooseberry Hill for a PD day on Leading Lights initiatives and the response from all staff was very positive.
4. **Sacred Saints Sports**  
The second fixture for Sacred Saints Sport will take place this Friday at the same venues as round one – Maida Vale
5. **Student Mid-Year Reports**  
Due to CEWA introducing their own changes to student reporting process in 2019 it was decided to NOT introduce student reports online and stick to the paper form for 2018 and introduce Online Reporting in 2019
6. **LifeLink Launch**  
Senior Leaders and school Principal attended the launch along with 75 other Catholic Primary Schools in the Perth Diocese. Archbishop Timothy Costelloe officially launched LifeLink 2018.
7. **Kimberley Calling**  
This CEWA initiative has been emailed to ALL Catholic Schools in order to promote and encourage teachers and leaders of Catholic Schools to spend time in the Kimberley Schools.
8. **Leadership Cluster Meeting**  
Good Shepherd hosted 6 Catholic Schools and their Leadership Teams in our region to discuss school and curriculum matters ranging from school planning days for 2019, new reporting system for Pre Primary students, National Quality Standards, Leading Lights and new Principal Review Process.
